


How to meet us at NHS CONFED 2021

Booking a meeting with Skills for Health or member of the team:


1.) [Search](#) for Skills for Health in the Partners and Exhibitors area of the Navigation panel.



2.) To send a meeting request to either the Skills for Health stand or a specific member of our team, click on your chosen time you have the option to send a message to the person you wish to meet, then click Send Meeting Request.



3.) You will then be notified if your meeting request has been accepted. A member of our team will be ready to talk to you at your chosen time slot.


4.) If you already know the member of our team you would like to meet, please contact events@skillsforhealth.org.uk and we will set up a meeting for you.

Other ways to speak to us at NHS Confed:

1.) Visit our virtual stand and start a chat with us there. A member of the team will then be able to point you in the direction of the most suitable person to talk to. You can also start ad-hoc video calls with our team from this page.

2.) Send a connection request to members of our team.

3.) Once connections have been made you can chat using the message centre just like you would message someone on MS Teams or Skype.



4.) Keep an eye out for members our team at all the mainstage, breakout, and panel sessions. You can live chat with other viewers, we will be in the audience waiting to chat to you all.
